EDUCATION AND QUALIFICATIONS

EMPLOYMENT HISTORY

CURRENT

I am a practicing Advocate of the High Court as I am currently self-employed and have been for the last 31 years. Prior to my advocacy training I owned and managed a small home-based printing enterprise. I previously owned and managed a community based newspaper called The Criterion. The publication ran for approximately 9 years (from 2007 to 2015). Revenue for the tabloid paper was derived from advertising income and sponsorship. Apart from being the editor of the paper, my duties included coordinating and planning of the articles, adverts and layout of every edition, so that each monthly issue was published and distributed timeously. However, due to a lack of financial support, the publication was forced to close down.

The printing company which is still in operation to this day, provides a service to the public for printed materials, such as business cards, letterheads, invoice books, etc. We also do printing of

t-shirts caps, decals and other promotional items. My responsibility here covers the overall supervision and management of these functions which are carried out by staff members.

Furthermore, I am also a part time 'Chef', specialising in the purveying of Halaal cuisine. My team and I, comprising of trained cooks, are usually occupied during weekends, either at weddings and/or other functions or alternatively catering to the general public. This, I might add, has its rewards, which amongst others, has earned our team a good reputation.

CONCURRENT SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

I am currently also a member of the Central Muslim Burial society *aka* CMB, which handles most Muslim funerals in Tshwane and surrounds. It is a Non-Profit Organisation which I founded with the help of community members about 12 years ago and of which I am the current chairperson.

I was also a founding member of the Al-Asr Educational Institute based in Claudius. The institution is still running successfully to this day.

Position -Project Cost Estimator.

Duties included the preliminary design and layout of water treatment plants for rural areas like large villages, filtration plants, water reticulation systems, etc. after studying the client requirements as specified in their tender enquiry documentation. The scope of work generally covered the special needs of various industries, municipalities, consulting engineers, architects etc. My responsibilities included the selection of mechanical and electrical equipment, viz. pumps, valves, piping, electrical switchgear, instrumentation, etc. to suit and complement the turnkey project, as well as the preparation of proposal/tender documents and the timeous submission of tenders before their due-dates. This would also involve prior discussions with clients to optimize their needs and to make suitable recommendations or advise clients on alternatives as and when needed.
